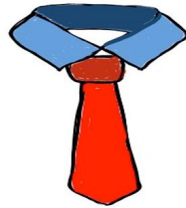

**1. BRAINSTORM CHAT:** Write all the words you can think of about the *Asahi Shimbun* on the board or on a piece of paper. Talk about these words with your partner(s).
